FOREWORD

In order to encourage and support architects to join the Conservation Register, the RIBA runs a Conservation Course that provides training which qualifies individuals to join the pathway at Conservation Registrant (CR) level. The aim of the register is for members to gather more experience through work, projects, and CPD to gain the relevant knowledge, skills and experience to apply for accreditation at Conservation Architect (CA) and ultimately Specialist Conservation Architect (SCA) accreditation level. Finding CPD which is suitable for addressing certain learning needs, particularly at CA and SCA level, can be difficult. This CPD Pathway aims to signpost CPD training which we think is appropriate at each level of the RIBA Conservation Register, and which addresses particular elements of the skills matrix (page 30 of the Handbook) at each respective level.


The Pathway has been designed to provide a focus and impetus for specialist CPD and training through an accessible and progressive system. Each level has CPD training which we feel is suitable for maintaining an accreditation, and 'progression' CPD which we would recommend for individuals aiming to apply for an accreditation one level higher. However, we would like to emphasise that many of the courses can be applied at a variety of levels, and our designations are not absolute. If, for example, an SCA lacks a particular set of traditional building skills, courses in the CR or CA tables will still be relevant to learning these skills. Likewise, accredited architects who are particularly skilled in one domain, but less skilled in another may look at courses in any of the tables to 'balance' their learning outcomes.

The list is not exhaustive, and the courses on the Pathway are suggestions, not requirements. They are not formally endorsed by the RIBA. Indeed, we certainly encourage members to go beyond these courses and to seek out other training which they think is suitable. We would also like to highlight the reading list on page 34 of the handbook which can be utilised for supplementary reading. The handbook <u>can be found on our website</u>.

The Conservation Register mentoring scheme is an additional initiative which benefits both register members and prospective applicants. Register Mentors receive complementary training from external mentor trainers and will help applicants review their case studies. The CPD Pathway will be updated annually to ensure that the recommended courses are up to date, with all of the courses receiving approval from our Conservation Register Steering Group.

As per the Handbook, one of the requirements to be met in order to become a Conservation Registrant is the completion of a suitable course, which is based on the ICOMOS Guidelines and includes a minimum of 21 hours of structured learning.
