What to do



The 'One to Fifties' are a group of mini people who are only 3 or 4cm high. They've been evacuated from their home and need somewhere to stay.



Design and build a shelter for the various families and groups that need a home.



Using found and recycled materials, build shelters in the Millennium Trail area of Patcham Junior School.



The home (or shelter) will need to include all the spaces they need to live their lives - to sleep, eat, cook, rest, play games, go to the toilet and anything else.



Start by thinking of all different buildings. Find pictures magazines to bring along of a house, offices, huts, sheds, kennels, castle, hotel, homes - anything!



Think about how you can make a model home for the little people. Bring along pictures of houses vou like.



A group of mini people have been discovered in the grounds of Patcham Junior School. They call themselves, The One to Fifties.

Teachers Ms Ross and Ms Gough were walking through the garden area when they spotted some suspicious movement. 'I thought it was a group of big ants behaving strangely, but on closer inspection I saw what looked like a group of Borrowers', said Ms Gough.

The mini people introduced themselves as The One to Fifties, a people who are tiny and only grow to about 3 or 4cm in height. They explained they had to move from their homeland and were looking for somewhere they could stay and settle down. The Patcham Junior School Millennium Walk was the perfect solution. The One to Fifties like to live in 5 sustainable housing and try not to cause any damage to their environment & surroundings, or the local ecology - so the Millennium Walk seemed a perfect fit.



What can you do to help?

If you can spare a day to help these people, they will be very very grateful. All you need to do is save some recycled materials to build a new home for them somewhere on the Millennium Walk. More information is on the right of the article.
