Who can join

Associate members must meet one of the following criteria:

- RIBA recognised Parts 1 and 2 (or equivalent)
- Have been awarded a qualification in architecture which is covered by the Professional Qualifications Directive (2005/36/ EC) and have access to the profession of architect in the country in which the qualification was gained

Students studying RIBA validated Parts 1 and 2 should apply for RIBA Student Membership.


