What happens next

1. Your name will be put forward for election to the nearest Membership Admission Committee, which takes place on the 15th of every month.
2. A welcome email will be sent within 7 working days of that confirming if your application has been successful.
3. A welcome pack will be sent within 2-3 weeks of election, containing your membership card and details on how to get the most from your membership.

Who can join

Chartered Members must meet one of the following criteria:

- RIBA recognised Parts 1, 2 and 3 (or equivalent)
- A qualification in architecture which is covered by the EU Professional Qualifications Directive (2005/36/EC) with access to the profession of architect in the EU country in which the qualification was gained and a minimum of 2 years of professional practical experience

Please note you must be registered with the Architects Registration Board (ARB) in order to practise as, and use the title of 'Architect' in the UK. Please visit www.arb.org.uk for more information.
