### Who can join

**Associate members must meet one of the following criteria:**

- RIBA recognised Parts 1 and 2 (or equivalent)
- Have been awarded a qualification in architecture which is covered by the Professional Qualifications Directive (2005/36/EC) and have access to the profession of architect in the country in which the qualification was gained

**Students studying RIBA validated Parts 1 and 2 should apply for RIBA Student Membership.**
