A new President for RSAW

2017 saw two RSAW Presidents in office – Carolyn Merrifield was elected in the spring to succeed Robert Firth, who completed his two-year term in September. Carolyn will serve from 2017 to 2019, with Robert in the role of Immediate Past President; the next President (2019 – 2021) will be elected in spring 2018 by a ballot of all members in Wales.

Llywydd newydd RSAW

Bu gan RSAW ddau Lywydd yn 2017 – etholwyd Carolyn Merrifield yn y gwanwyn i olynu Robert Firth gan fod ei dymor o ddwy flynedd yn dod i ben ym mis Medi. Bydd Carolyn yn Llywydd o 2017 i 2019, gyda Robert yn Gyn-Llywydd Diwethaf; etholir y Llywydd nesaf (2019 – 2021) yng ngwanwyn 2018 trwy bleidlais gan yr holl aelodau yng Nghymru.

Introduction/Cyflwyniad Robert Firth

I have just completed my second spell as President of the Royal Society of Architects in Wales and it has been an honour to be voted in to do this important role again.

Over the last two years I have travelled all over Wales and back and forth to London, Belfast and Dublin, spreading the message on the quality of Welsh architectural design to a variety of audiences - developers, councils, government departments, the construction industry and the public. I think the message is getting through but the effort needs to be unceasing.

Fair procurement is, in my view, still the biggest issue by far, but the architect's role in the construction industry, BIM, political lobbying, sustainable design, fee levels and the continuing rise in design and build contracts will all play their part in shaping the profession in the years to come.

Rwyf newydd gwblhau fy ail gyfnod fel Llywydd Cymdeithas Frenhinol Penseiri yng Nghymru a bu'n anrhydedd cael fy ethol i wneud y swydd bwysig hon eilwaith.

Dros y ddwy flynedd ddiwethaf, rwyf wedi teithio ledled Cymru ac yn ôl a blaen i Lundain, Belfast a Dilyn, gan roi'r gair ar led am safon pensaerniaeth yng Nghymru i wahanol gynulleidfaoedd – datblygwyr, cynghorau, adrannau'r llywodraeth, y diwydiant adeiladu a'r cyhoedd. Rwy'n meddwl bod pobl yn dechrau deall ond mae'n rhaid dal ati.

Yn fy marn i, prosesau caffael teg yw'r mater pwysicaf o bell o hyd, ond bydd rôl y pensaer yn y diwydiant adeiladu, BIM, lobbio gwleidyddol, dylunio cynaliadwy, lefelau ffioedd a'r cynnydd mewn contractau dylunio ac adeiladu oll yn chwarae eu rhan yn llywio'r proffesiwn yn y blynyddoedd nesaf.

The Inquiry into the terrible events at Grenfell Tower will be very important for the architectural profession's role in an increasingly disjointed approach to construction and building regulations across the UK. The RIBA has made some very useful and pertinent statements on how this should be improved - I hope the 'powers that be' listen. This should never happen again.

My last plea. Please work together. Architects practices and practitioners in Wales are frequently strangers to each other. We need a strong voice AND we need it to be heard in the right place - at the heart of the construction industry influencing government, public authorities and clients.

I wish Carolyn Merrifield many congratulations and the very best of luck for the next two years in her role as RSAW President. She has my full support.

Bydd yr ymchwiliad i drychineb Tŵr Grenfell yn chwarae rhan bwysig iawn yn rôl y proffesiwn pensaernïol wrth fynd i'r afael â'r ymateb di-drefn i reoliadau adeiladu ledled y Deyrnas Unedig. Background

Tracing its origins back to the late 19th century, the Royal Society of Architects in Wales (RSAW) was granted the Royal pre-fix in 1994 and represents and supports around 700 Chartered Members of our parent body, the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA), who live and work in Wales.

A team of four staff (two full-time, two part-time) employed by the RIBA works on members' behalf from a base in Cardiff's Creative Quarter and a network of volunteer-led Branches operate in North, South, Mid and West Wales. RSAW strives to be an authoritative information source able to represent the voice of the architectural profession in Wales, bringing influence to bear on Welsh Government and related agencies.

We connect with leading figures in the political and creative arenas through our Honorary Member programme and we promote the value of good design through awards schemes, exhibitions, festivals and conferences, regularly working in partnership with other professional bodies and Welsh national organisations.

What RSAW does

Activities engaging members in the civic and political life of Wales

We work with partners to deliver high-profile, public-facing events such as the National Eisteddfod with Design Commission for Wales and an exhibition celebrating Welsh architecture in the Senedd building.

Welsh Government policy

We respond to all Welsh Government consultation documents relating to the built environment; we engage with Constructing Excellence Wales, Design Commission for Wales, the National Procurement Service, CITB Professional Services Group, cross-party meetings etc and keep members informed through regular updates.

Influencing - bringing the value of design to initiatives and debates

The Metro Urban Density (MUD) initiative, exploring the impact of proposed metro stations on neighbourhoods pioneered by Design Circle (South Wales Branch) continues to influence and inform good practice; while a talk by the winning designers of a glamping design competition was a popular public event in the Wales Festival of Architecture 2017.

Maintenance of professional standards

Through the Wales Future Practice programme and seminars linking with new legislation, members are able to keep knowledge and skills up-to-date.

Promotion of good design through members' work

With exhibitions of each year's Award-winning buildings and local displays showing the value architects bring to the community, we promote the achievements of architects in Wales, from small scale to major projects.

Education

We work with Cardiff University (Welsh School of Architecture) and UWTSD (the new Swansea School of Architecture) to co-ordinate a 'practice experience programme' with local practitioners for second-year students.

Role as a 'Learned Society'

We co-publish with the University of Wales Press The Architecture of Wales series, while Touchstone Review provides an annual update on new and projected developments.

Mae RSAW yn ymdrechu i fod yn ffynhonnell awdurdodol o wybodaeth a all gynrychioli llais y proffesiwn pensaernïol yng Nghymru, gan ddylanwadu ar Lywodraeth Cymru ac asiantaethau cysylltiedig.

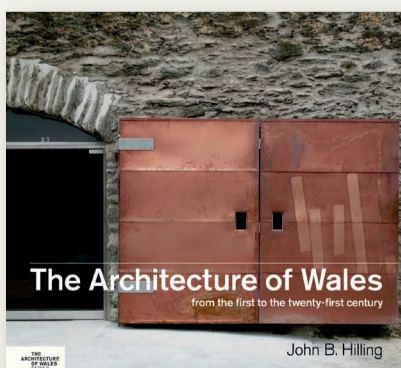

- Bu'r Conservation Coach poblogaidd mewn tri lle yng ngogledd Cymru o dan arweiniad arbenigol Dr Mark Baker – Plas Teg, Castell Gwrych a Hafodunos.
- Cynhaliodd Design Circle (Cangen De Cymru, RSAW) Weithdy Dylunio'n edrych ar leoliad yn Rhiwbeina, gogledd Caerdydd, gan elwa ar lwyddiant charrette MUD 2016 a ariannwyd gan LIF.
- Trefnodd Cymdeithas Penseiri Gogledd Cymru (NWSA) ymweliad astudio â Storyhouse, canolfan ddiwylliannol newydd Caer.

- Wales Festival of Architecture 2017
Featuring 5 exhibitions, 4 talks, 1 design charrette, 2 building tours and 8 films, the highlight was a talk by the two Welsh winners of the Legendary Glamping design competition, an international competition to design 8 glamping units which became a pop-up hotel on sites throughout Wales this summer. Rural Office for Architecture's Niall Maxwell and Carwyn Lloyd Jones of CAT appeared in the accompanying Channel 4 series Cabins in the Wild.
- Welsh Architecture Awards presentation ceremony
75 guests attended the Awards ceremony at one of 2016's winning buildings, Cardiff and Vale College, to see two buildings win Welsh Architecture Awards. RSAW Welsh Building of the Year and Client of the Year was awarded to Silver House by Hyde + Hyde Architects, while Hall + Bednarczyk were awarded RSAW Small Project of the Year for The Chickenshed.
- The RSAW Spring School at Portmeirion took the theme of the Six Nations rugby championship, with six architects representing Italy, France, Scotland, Ireland, England and Wales.
- The popular Conservation Coach visited three locations in North Wales under the expert guidance of Dr Mark Baker – Plas Teg, Gwrych Castle and Hafodunos.
- Design Circle (RSAW South Branch) ran a Design Workshop exploring a location in Rhiwbina, north Cardiff, drawing on the success of 2016's LIF-funded MUD charrette.
- North Wales Society of Architects (NWSA) organised a building study visit to Storyhouse, Chester's new cultural centre.



June July August

- Touchstone 2017 was distributed to over 1000 recipients, including RSAW members and a wide range of client groups and cultural/ bookshop outlets.
- The RSAW President and Director joined the teams from RIBA, RSUA, RIAS and RIAI for the 5 Presidents Meeting, this time hosted by RIBA in London. Subjects included the Grenfell Tower fire and responses by the professional bodies, and the impact of Brexit in the constituent parts of the UK and Ireland.
- West Wales Branch and Mid-Wales Branch joint event: a talk and discussion on Wales: the state of the architectural nation, at Cardigan Castle, attracting architects and planners from 6 local authority areas.
- Announcement of the National Eisteddfod shortlist for the 2017 festival on Anglesey: CUBRIC, IBI Group; Rhyl High School, AHR Architects; Silver House, Hyde + Hyde Architects; Ysgol Bae Baglan, Stride Treglown Ltd.
- Design Circle organised the second Skyline competition, on the theme of landscape. Second-time winner Priit Jurimae received a gift donated by long-term RSAW sponsor Ibstock.
- Work continued on the second book in the Architecture of Wales series, a joint publishing venture with University of Wales Press.
- National Eisteddfod of Wales, Anglesey; the Gold Medal was presented to Stride Treglown Architects for Ysgol Bae Baglan; the Architecture Scholarship was won by Myfyr Jones-Evans.
- The National Eisteddfod hosted a Welsh-language discussion panel on the influence of Frank Lloyd Wright on Welsh architecture, attended by 60 guests.

- September saw the election of RSAW's new President for the 2017 – 2019 session, Carolyn Merrifield. The RSAW Honorary Secretary is Geraint Roberts and the Honorary Treasurer is Andy Sutton.
- RSAW staff and/or members attended the IWA conference Wales Said Yes, marking 20 years since the Welsh Devolution referendum; CITB Wales Board dinner; ARB consultation on criteria; and the ground-breaking ceremony for the Centre for Wales Innovation and Construction (CWIC launch) at UWTSW Swansea.
- CPD sessions included a Working with Clients session with Constructing Excellence in Wales; a Victorian/Edwardian-themed Conservation Coach (South); updates on the requirement to submit Heritage Impact Assessments; a session on residential acoustics; a Design Commission for Wales design charrette on Merthyr Tydfil's industrial heritage.
- RSAW staff and NWSA members took part in a fringe event at the Plaid Cymru party political conference in Caernarfon, co-hosted with other built environment professional bodies.
- The 24th RSAW Annual Conference *Brave New World – the next ten years for architectural practice in Wales* – featured Dr Rory Hyde, Curator of Contemporary Architecture and Urbanism, V&A Museum and Mary Duggan, of Mary Duggan Architects.
- The exhibition, *A Celebration of Welsh Architecture in words and photographs*, highlighting projects shortlisted for awards in 2017 was on display in the Oriel of the Senedd in November and December. Jane Hutt AM sponsored the exhibition and launch reception for 40+ members, AMs and guests.
- Mid-Wales Branch hosted talks to mark the 150th anniversary of the birth of Frank Lloyd Wright, given by Jonathan Adams who wrote and presented the BBC Wales TV programme *Frank Lloyd Wright: the man who built America*.
- A joint event at Cardigan Castle, linking Mid and West-Wales Branches, brought together architects and planners to explore good practice in the historic environment. The session was co-hosted by RTPI Cymru and IHBC Wales as part of the All-Wales Ideas Forum, funded through the RIBA's Local Initiative Fund.
- RSAW welcomed a new Honorary Member – Menna Richards, former Controller of BBC Wales, in a ceremony at Insole Court, Cardiff.

As well as the activities listed above, RSAW staff, President and members of Council regularly attend meetings at the RIBA, including RIBA Council, Nations and Regions committee and Regional Management group, to report on activity and share experience; we also organise video-linked Council meetings to connect the four Branches four times a year and we undertake visits to practices and Branch meetings whenever possible.

The Year Ahead

In recent years, RSAW and RIBA have agreed to realign RSAW's relation with RIBA to more appropriately reflect the political and business reality brought about by devolution for its members in Wales. A dedicated budget 'to facilitate engagement in the political and civic life of Wales' has helped RSAW to develop and deliver initiatives and partnerships appropriate to its status in the life of a nation with a strong political and cultural identity. In 2018 we will nurture and consolidate these initiatives as we continue to raise the profile and influence of architects in Wales.

RSAW's programme of work for 2018 will focus on the RIBA's objective to serve members and society in order to deliver better buildings and places, stronger communities and a sustainable environment. We will apply inclusive, environmental and ethical values in the Welsh context by embedding the overarching values of the Wellbeing of Future Generations (Wales) Act in all our initiatives.

We recognise we particularly need to serve the needs of members who conduct business through the Welsh language and to be able to comply with the spirit of the Welsh Language (Wales) Measure 2011.

In our dealings with Welsh Government, we aim to become more proactive, identifying opportunities for the architectural profession in Wales to shape inclusive and progressive policies for the future.

Activity highlights 2018

Spring

- North Wales Society of Architects will join forces with the innovation team at Pontio, Bangor University, for a series of public talks on the theme of 'new ways of thinking'.
- The RSAW Spring School takes place on Friday 11 May at Portmeirion. Italian architect Alfonso Femia <http://www.atelierfemia.com/en/profile/> will be the Inspiration Hour speaker, talking about his work throughout Europe.
- We will implement the findings of the feasibility study for a national archive of Welsh architectural drawings.
- The 2018 Wales Festival of Architecture (April and May) will host events in all four Branch areas, including a 'Be an Architect for the Day' event at Aberystwyth Arts Centre and the winners day for the Shape My Street design competition for primary schools in Wales, with WSA and DCFW.
- We anticipate a joint initiative with Design Commission for Wales and RTPI Cymru to engage with Welsh Government's National Development Framework.

Summer

- With the National Eisteddfod coming to Cardiff Bay this August, Design Circle will be involved in additional interactive activities to enhance the established exhibition of shortlisted buildings.

Autumn

- The second book in the RSAW/University of Wales Press series The Architecture of Wales will be launched in September. *The Architecture of Wales: from the first to the twenty-first century* by John B Hilling, with additional chapters by Professor Simon Unwin and Jonathan Vining.

Winter

- The RSAW Annual Conference reaches its 'silver' anniversary, celebrating 25 years since its first appearance at the Metropole Hotel in Llandrindod Wells in 1994
