Background

<u>Built for the Environment</u> is a report published by the RIBA and Architects Declare that demonstrates the critical role that the built environment can – and must – play to reduce the alarming rise of greenhouse gas emissions.



The report brings together various pieces of research and evidence to encourage the sector to embrace and scale-up capabilities, and sets out key recommendations to governments ahead of COP26.

RIBA and Architects Declare now seek organisations from across the sector to endorse the report, which trails the <u>Built Environment</u> <u>Summit</u> – a two-day virtual conference on 28 and 29 October that will provide an opportunity for the sector to unite ahead of COP26.
